## APCAM Awards

To popularise and implement high standards of professionalism among ADR professionals, ADR academics, ADR users and ADR researchers and to develop and consistently upgrade the quality of ADR, APCAM has launched "APCAM International ADR Awards". The Awards will honour all significant contributions working towards ensuring quality ADR services and for path-breaking innovations and partnerships. The awardees will be showcased during the Annual APCAM International Summit, which will be a confluence of the ADR, legal and business community in the region, to discuss and deliberate on the latest trends and developments of disputes and its resolutions. The awards will go a long way in motivating ADR activists to join this movement for the overall improvement of research and development in the professionalism and credibility of ADR.

Registrations and nominations for Awards 2023 are open from 25th February 2023, and closes on 15th April 2023. The awards would be declared and the awardees honoured during the Award night scheduled on 6th May 2023 during the APCAM Summit on 6-7 May 2023 at New Delhi, India.



## Award Categories

There are 10 categories of APCAM Awards.

### Arbitrator of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as an Arbitrator of domestic or international disputes.

### Arbitration Practitioner (Advocate) of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as an Arbitration Practitioner in domestic and/or international disputes.

### Arbitration Law Firm of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as an Arbitration Law Firm in domestic and/or international disputes.

### Mediator of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as a Mediator of domestic or international disputes.

### Mediation Practitioner (Advocate) of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as a Mediation Practitioner in domestic and/or international disputes.

### Mediation Law Firm of the Year

This Award recognises superior performance as a Mediation Law Firm in domestic and/or international disputes.

7

### Mediation Academic of the Year

This Award recognises the achievements of individuals who have in the last 12 months demonstrated excellence in academia in the field of mediation and their work has benefitted in more students or participants in taking interest in mediation to use negotiation or mediation to achieve outcomes in more effectively resolving disputes.

### Arbitration Academic of the Year

This Award recognises the achievements of individuals who have in the last 12 months demonstrated excellence in academia in the field of arbitration and their work has benefitted in more students or participants in taking interest in arbitration to use arbitration to achieve outcomes in more effectively resolving disputes.

### ADR University/College of the Year


This APCAM Award recognises the achievements of Universities or Colleges which have in the last 12 months demonstrated excellence in academia in the field of mediation and/or arbitration and their work has benefitted in more students or participants in taking interest in ADR as a better alternative for resolving disputes.

### ADR User of the Year


This APCAM Award recognises superior performance of an organisation / business entity, as an Alternative Dispute Resolution User, including mediation, conciliation, arbitration or other hybrid methods in resolving domestic and/or international disputes effectively.





# How to Submit or Recommend Nominations

- ▶ Participation for the APCAM Awards is available exclusively to professionals and organisations in the APCAM member countries, which include Australia, Hong Kong, India, Indonesia, Malaysia, Nepal, South Korea and Thailand.
- ▶ Please access the application form for each award category and submit the entries online. No offline submissions or submissions via e-mail will be accepted.
- ▶ Only one entry is eligible for consideration in one category. Separate entries should be made if the same organisation/person is applying in more than one category. Separate form should be used for each application entry.
- ▶ You can also recommend nominations of excellent professionals and organisations in the APCAM member countries, whom you think are worthy of the award.
